

Archbishop Wester graced us with words of wisdom on Friday evening as we honored those of our community who have passed. The main presenters were from our own deacon community: Deacon Chuck Navarrete (Our Lady of Fatima); Deacon Dave Little (currently residing in the Diocese of Dallas); Deacon Richard Roybal (St. Anthony, Pecos) and three newly ordained deacons—Buck Sanchez (Nativity, ABQ), Arthur Trujillo (OLOG, Peralta) and Francisco Rodriguez, Sacred Heart, Clovis).

Highlighting the retreat were options for spiritual growth. Evening Prayer and Mass both on Friday and Saturday, opportunities for reconciliation, an adoration chapel, the rosary, and inspiring words of wisdom from our speakers.





Rebuild My Church Update

The Pastoral Plan that is a result of the Rebuild My Church Initiative, was promulgated at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi in Santa Fe on Wednesday, October 1. This followed

the acceptance of plans from each of the eight deaneries as well as a plan from the Catholic Pastoral Center (the 9th deanery). Each of the leaders from each deanery were also awarded the St. Francis Medal.

This plan is dynamic and the primary focus is implementation. Action plans are currently being developed.

Deacons play a critical role in the success of this initiative. As agents of the Archbishop our role is to promote his agenda and to assist parishes and deaneries in their efforts to rebuild our church. This is most critical as we continue to heal from bankruptcy and the effects that the covid pandemic had on our parishes and missions.



St. Stephen Fund



This fund is established according to the Archdioceses of Santa Fe Deacon Council by-laws and constitution. It is an approved fund for the designated purpose of giving financial assistance to Permanent Deacons and/or their wives. The St. Stephen Fund is intended to be temporary assistance during a time of crisis or when grave financial need has been identified. Assistance from the fund is intended to be a one-time gift, but under certain circumstances the St Stephen Fund Committee may decide to help on more then one occasion. The Permanent Deacon or widow requesting assistance must complete a Request for <u>ASSISTANCE FORM</u> and send to the St Stephen Fund Committee for review and then forward to the Office of the Director of Dea-

cons for action.

If you would like to transfer from your current assignment, please contact the Office of Deacons. Requests must be submitted in writing before they can be acted on. Once the office has received your request, and a new assignment location has been agreed to, both your current pastor and the pastor of the parish of your new assignment will also be required to submit letters. Once this is accomplished, the Archbishop will make the final decision and issue a letter with the change of assignment.
